

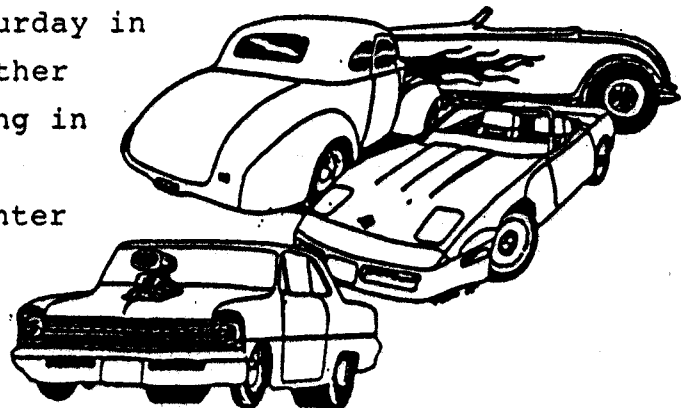
May's meeting was a lot of fun. For those of you who didn't make it, tsk tsk tsk.
